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Introduction

The Duncan Hospital is a 200-bedded hospital. The hospital is situated on the Indo Nepal border and is a busy general hospital with various specialties and active Community Health Program.

The school was established in 1955 and recognized by The Indian Nursing Council (INC) and the Bihar Nurses Registration council affiliated to The Mid India Board of Education of Nurses League of CMAI



APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR GNM COURSE

- Read the prospectus carefully and whether you are eligible to apply for GNM course.
- Male and female candidates can apply for the course
- Applicants must give their full address with PIN code and phone number.
- All information provided in the application form should be correct. If any candidate produces fake certificate or information he/she shall be disqualified from the course as soon as it is detected and any fee paid already will not be refunded.
- Only photocopies of necessary certificates should be uploaded with the application form and all the original documents must be available with the candidate at the time of the interview.

FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

The foreign nationals need to obtain Equivalence Certificate to study in India issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi.

This is applicable to only Nepali Citizen, GNM training will be offered to the candidate and candidate should apply for registration in their own country after the completion of the course as per the Indian Nursing council notice (with effect from 2015)

For 3 years of training, full fees should be paid in three installments after the training.

ADMISSION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Minimum Education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM

- Applicant must have passed 10+2 or its equivalent with an aggregate average mark of 40% and above, preferably science and must have taken English as a subject in class 12th.
 - 10+2 with 40% marks from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) a Central Government.
 - 10 + 2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
 - 10 + 2 with English having 40% of marks in a vocational stream –Health care science from a recognized CBSE/State/center.
 - Registered ANM Nurse with pass mark. There is no age bar for ANM candidates.
 - Minimum age for admission will be 17 years (as of 31st December of that year). The upper age limit is 35 years.
 - Male and Female candidates are eligible to apply for the GNM course.
 - Marital Status: Single/married.
 - The candidate should be medically fit to undergo the course.
 - Admission of students will be once a year.
 - A candidate is allowed a maximum of 6 years to complete the course. Failure to comply means the candidate is disqualified from the course and will not be allowed to attend the examination.
- (Subject to change as per INC regulations)

PRE- NURSING TEST

The Pre-Nursing Test (PNT) will be held on June 15, 2026 at School of Nursing Duncan Hospital Raxaul.

PRE- NURSING TEST RESULT

The result of the Pre-Nursing Test will be notified after 2-3 weeks by email, or telephone to the candidates who qualified entrance examination. The selected candidates will be called for interview as per the date intimated.

After final selection Rs.10000/- (INR) to be deposited for seat reservation which will be adjusted with the annual fee.

INSTRUCTIONS: Candidates are expected to bring the following original documents at the time of interview.

- High School /Higher secondary (10th and 12th) Mark sheets and pass certificates
- Transfer certificates (College/School leaving certificates)
- Conduct certificates (School/college)
- Citizen or domicile certificate (from the Local Govt. office)
- Migration certificate for other than Bihar state candidates.
- Candidates belonging to India must produce a copy of AADAHAR Card & PAN Card during Admission (Mandatory requirement).
- During admission original certificates must be brought and if not available provisional certificates must be produced.

THE DECISION OF THE SELECTION COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL

SPONSORSHIP

- The sponsoring agency can be EHA unit, any NGO or a person, who undertakes to financially sponsor the student.
- The sponsored students should pay the fee as per instructions given in the prospectus.
- For sponsored candidates, a letter from the sponsoring body / agency duly signed by the Head of the organization should be submitted along with the application form.

VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES –

The verification fee will be charged separately as per the Instruction of the Individual Educational Board immediately after admission.

ADMISSION

Admission sessions of GNM course starts from 1stAugust each year. (Subject to change as per the Indian Nursing Council Notice)

DURATION OF THE COURSE

The duration of General Nursing and Midwifery course is 3 years from 2026 to 2029.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR MIBE BOARD EXAMINATION

If the principal certifies that

- A student has completed minimum 11 months of the course.
- A student has attended minimum of 80% theory classes and 100% practical to appear in the Board exam.
- A student must secure 50% marks in internal assessment separately for theory and practical
- All the requirements are complete, both the theory and practical internal examinations are conducted and internal assessment marks are sent to the board.

SALIENT RULES OF NURSING SCHOOL

- Students are expected to obey the rules and regulations of the School and the hostel.
- Students are not permitted to visit anyone inside or outside the campus without permission.
- Prior permission should be taken to go out of the campus.
- Prior information must be intimated to the Principal's Office before the parents or guardians visit.
- At the time of admission, parents/guardians must give a list of a minimum of 5 visitors so they would allow the students to meet in the future. Parents/guardians can meet the students once in three months. Frequent visits are not permissible.
- The Principal has the right to open any letter or parcel sent to the students and deal them accordingly.
- Mobile Phones are allowed to use for two days during the weekend and should submit on the first day of every week to the responsible class teachers. If anyone is caught hiding extra mobiles or noticed any misuse of phones, then the training period will be extended 1 month extra and depending on the usage of mobile phones.
- Cooking is not allowed inside the room / hostel.
- Special leaves will be granted on cases of any emergency. (Extra leaves need to be compensated within the training period)

LEAVE AND VACATION

- 1st year : 28 days
- 2nd year : 28 days
- 3rd year : 14 days
- Sick leave : A maximum of 10 days per year
- Preparation leave : 7 days before the Board Examination
- Weekly day off 1 full day and one-half day
- National leave : 6 days per year

ANTI-RAGGING RESOLUTION

- Any student indulged in ragging can be expelled from the training institute as per the UGC regulations.

BOARDING

- Hostel accommodation and food are provided to all the students.
- Students must reside in the Hostel.

SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

- All the students should participate in Student Nurses" Association activities during the training program.

HEALTH CARE

- All candidates are expected to be immunized against Hepatitis B and must produce a medical certificate at the time of admission.
- Treatment concession will be given to the students up to Rs. 2000 per year for minor ailments. Expenses beyond Rs. 2000 must be paid by the parents or guardians.

UNIFORM

- Uniforms can be purchased by the students later.
- 2 sets of blue scrubs for clinical sessions and 2 sets of blue uniforms for community health posting and black pant for boys.

SUSPENSION / DISMISSAL/ TERMINATION

There are few instances where a student can be dismissed / terminated from the course and has to pay the entire course fee to the institution.

- Pregnancy
- Forging signatures
- Attempt to suicide
- Loss of Patient's Life
- Substance abuse, smoking, cheating, Fighting, stealing etc.
- Inability to pass the annual MIBE exams consecutively, more than the stipulated time (>6 Years) as per the criteria, Indian Nursing Council

NEEDED ITEMS FOR THE TRAINING

Selected candidates are expected to bring the following items

- Black sandals (This can be bought after three months)
- Black Sweater
- Black full cardigan and warm clothes for winter season.
- Blankets, mattress, quilt, bed sheets pillow with cover
- Mosquito net, towels Buckets & Mug.
- Trunk with lock and key.
- Wristwatch, torch umbrella, calculator nail cutter, inch-tape, pencil pouch etc.
- Salwar are preferable and colour Saree for occasional use

- Affiliation Fee, Exam Fee, Building Fund & MIBE Materials in First Year
- Affiliation Fee, Exam Fee & MIBE Materials in Second Year
- Affiliation Fee, Exam Fee, MIBE Materials ,Diploma & Registration Fee in Third Year
- Books- Optional (Those who are willing to buy should inform the principal after final selection process)
- uniform can be purchased after the selection process

B - Subsidized Fee Structure

Those who opt to pay the subsidized fees are required to fulfil a service commitment of two years in any Units of E.H.A hospitals once the posting order is received from the central office New Delhi.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FEE PAYMENT

- Every student must clear their academic fees before 31st March of each year.
- If the students are not paying fees before exam, they will not be eligible to write the Board exam.
- Students, who are paying fees in installments, can pay in 3 installments i.e.

1st Installment within October to November

- First year (Rs.33,283 + 8,000 mess fee)
- Second year (Rs.34,350 + 8,000 mess fee)
- Third year (Rs.32,967 + 8,000 mess fee)

2nd Installment within December to January

- First year (Rs. Rs.33,283 + 8,000 mess fee)
- Second year (Rs.34,350 + 8,000 mess fee)
- Third year (Rs.32,967 + 8,000 mess fee)

3rd Installment on or before March 25th

- First year (33,283+ 8,000 mess fee)
- Second year (Rs.34,350 + 8,000 mess fee)
- Third year (Rs.32,967 + 8,000 mess fee)

- Those who are unable to pay before March 31st they have to pay a Fine of 5% for the remaining fee if not paid within April to May
- Fine of 10% for the remaining fee if not paid within June to July
- Fine of 15% for the remaining fee if not paid before or on 20 August

Hall ticket will not be issued to appear in the Board Exam. If the academic fee is not paid within the stipulated time.

The Management reserves the right to revise the fee every year for the course subject to change as per the Institutional Policy.
